Here is some information to help you prepare for back to school during the summer:

COVID-19 restrictions or changes:

- The start of the school year will be prepared based on the recommendations of the province's chief medical officer, MÉDPE directives and according to a plan drawn up by the Conseil scolaire francophone provincial de TNL.
- At this time, we have not received any information in regard to the start of the 2022 school year.
- You may receive press releases and memos with changes during the summer. Please check your email regularly.

School transportation :

- New pupils: the deadline for registration for school transport has already passed. You must contact sroberts@csfp.nl.ca at the CSFP as soon as possible in order to register.
- Relocation or change of address: Please notify srobert@csfp.nl.ca as soon as possible. Allow 2 weeks for the route to be changed.
- The routes will be posted on the CSFP website before the start of the school year: www.csfp.nl.ca

Uniforms:

- Wearing a uniform will be mandatory for the start of the school year.

Main office

First day for all students:

- Classes resume, normally, for students on Wednesday, September 7, 2022.
- Buses will arrive at the school between 8:30 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. Students arriving on foot or by car can enter through the Atrium at 8:30 a.m. as well.
- Students must bring their lunch and they must be dressed appropriately to play outside.
- Students can bring their school materials on the first day.
- We give a hug and say goodbye to parents at the door!
- Wearing a uniform is mandatory.

- Parents or guardians must bring their child to school on the first day.
- There will be a welcome session. More details will be sent in due time.
